OUR PURPOSE:

Iron Rose Sister Ministries (IRSM) exists to equip women to connect to God and one another more deeply across the Americas.

The resources we offer are available in English, Spanish, Portuguese, and in various bilingual contexts (E/S, S/P, E/P).

Books

Interactive Bible studies designed to be simple enough for anyone to lead and deep enough for everyone to grow, written for small group context and personal growth (See insert).

Seminars, Ladies' Days, Retreats

Through in-person visits or virtual events, speakers present personal and practical Bible-based lessons. Ideally, after each lesson, questions are discussed in small groups.
